The Creative Nonfiction Collective (CNFC) conference takes place at Emmanuel College of Victoria University in the University of Toronto. The CNFC is committed to providing a welcoming and accessible environment for all conference attendees and visitors.

Emmanuel College ([75 Queen's Park Crescent](#)) is a fully accessible building. The accessible entrance is the Queen's Park Crescent entrance (west side of the building); the building has an elevator that services all four floors. The single-user, all-gender, accessible washroom with baby changing station is on the main floor.

The Burwash Dining Hall ([70 Charles Street West](#)) is also fully accessible (entrance off Charles Street), with accessible washrooms on the lower level (access via elevator).
